2 Whether it's fighting Out-of-Network reform or other challenges, the **NJSSA has become one of the nation's strongest state societies**, and has ensured the highest quality and safety for New Jersey residents.

3 Aside from your health, your family, friends and faith, **there is nothing more important than your profession**. You've worked very hard to become an anesthesiologist, and we work hard to make sure the practice of anesthesia stays strong in New Jersey.

4 **The pressure from paraprofessionals on expanding their scope of practice is stronger now than it has ever been;** Our best defense against this is strong relationships with NJ legislators on both sides of the aisle. These issues are often decided on a state-by-state basis, so far we have been successful but it takes money; it's a simple truth.

5 It's easy to look back and say things were better in the past, but if you want tomorrow to be better than today, **we need to invest in our future**. Maybe you are fortunate enough to be at the end of your career, and if so, fortunate enough to be able to help ensure the future for younger colleagues. You'll be glad you did!

6 We are at a critical crossroads for our profession; you can look the other way or get involved. If you have the skills, the connections and the time, **please volunteer and help advocate for NJ's anesthesiologists**; HOWEVER, if you don't have the skills, or the connections, or the time, **please contribute**. **This is an investment in the future of our profession and practices.**

7 While our national organization, the ASA, has been very influential and has done a tremendous job for anesthesiologists across the country, nobody knows NJ's particular issues like NJSSA does. **We advocate locally, where it counts.**

8 Our professional lobbying group, the Advocacy & Management Group is one of the very finest advocacy groups in the country; but even with their incredible talent, connections, experience and hard work, we still need to support NJ legislators. **They can't do it without us!**

9 BOTH individuals and corporations are legally able to donate to State PACs; so if you'd like to make a real difference, like many other groups have, **please consider making a corporation contribution**.
